## U9-High School Summary Document

Fall 2010-Spring 2011

**Club Fees** \$495 per full year players (\$300 High School / ½ year players)

- Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Managers and Board Members may receive discounts
- Parents with multiple children participating in the club will receive a \$50 discount per additional child applied to the youngest child first.
- Player Pass Fees - For players that are unable to play an entire season, the fees depend upon the number of games he/she will participate in. If they can participate in at least 10 games in a full year (5 for ½ year), normal fees will apply. If the player can participate in less than 10 games (5 for ½ year), 50% of the normal fees will be charged. The fees charged exclude additional team fees, uniform fees or volunteer fees described below.

**Uniform Fees** \$150 (Includes shirt, shorts, sock in both white and green and backpack). There are additional options for players needing partial uniforms replacements (shirt, shorts, socks etc.) All players must pay for their uniform fees. There are no club discounts available for uniforms.

**Team Fees** At the Coach/Manager discretion, they may charge additional team fees to cover indoor sessions, additional training sessions, additional tournaments, season ending parties, equipment, SLYSA league fees, etc...

### **Volunteer Buyout Fee:**

- Each family will be charged a \$60 volunteer deposit (\$30 ½ year). Upon completion of the 6 hours (3 for ½ year) of volunteer service, the deposit will be reimbursed. There will be no partial reimbursement.
- Children of Executive Board Members, Club Directors, Program Directors, Coaches and Managers will not be charged.
- The volunteer hours will be available for certain club functions (field set up, field day, concessions, fund raisers, etc...)
- All Fees not recovered by May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011 will be retained as donations to the club.

### **What do the fees cover:**

- Both Fall and Spring SISL Registration/Referee fees. All teams are encouraged to enter the SISL League. The team and parents shall be responsible for all fees to participate in other leagues (e.g. SLYSA, SCYSA, etc..)
- Each team will receive reimbursement of tournament entry fees in each season (Spring and Fall) as follows. Limits do apply. The team and parents shall be responsible for all fees for additional tournaments.
- Club training up to 4 times per month during the SISL seasons by a licensed trainer.
- Edwardsville 5<sup>th</sup> avenue training grounds for practices.
- Individual team website.

### **Parents Requirements/Responsibilities:**

- All Club Fees must be completely paid by September 30<sup>th</sup>. Team fees may be collected over a longer period of time.
- Uniform fees are due by July 23<sup>rd</sup> to insure arrival before season starts.
- To use District 7 Facilities, one person from every team must be AED certified (Parent, Coach, Manager or Player). Please contact your manager if you hold a current certification.
- Respect game officials and accept all decisions without question. Yelling at a game official is unacceptable.
- Respect teammates and opponents by demonstrating good sportsmanship at all times. Never using vulgar, degrading, or insulting language.
- Learn and understand the Laws of the Game, League rules, policies and procedures
- Respect coaching staff and other parents. Please contact your coach with any concerns you may have.
- Respect all practice and game property (home and away). Place trash in the trash receptacles.
- Represent the Glen-Ed Soccer Club in a positive manner.
